MEMBERSHIP we are in the process of compiling a list of Bi-Aura registered practitioners for distribution to the public. Obviously once this goes out it will be some time before another is distributed, so anyone who wishes to join the Foundation and be included on this list please let us have your application form as soon as possible. There has been some confusion over the insurance included in the membership fee. The cost to the foundation for membership insurance is £59.50 for british therapists and £86.50 for Irish therapists. Anyone who already has their own insurance and does not want the Bi-Aura insurance will have the relevant amount deducted from their membership fee. Equally there is a sliding scale on a quarterly basis for insurance and membership fees so please contact the office for the amount payable at any given time.

WEBSITE we are updating and trying to improve the website all the time and still await your testimonials from clients to put up there. The **members only site** is targeted to be the next priority and we aim to have it opened before Christmas. Meanwhile **please** let us have your ideas, stories, testimonials, points of view and

DIPLOMA COURSES Michael has just completed a course in Omagh and a new course in Dublin has just begun. The London course started on 8th & 9th September. This is the first course to take place in England and we have added an extra weekend into the course focussed more on the business side of things, a guest speaker will give advice on starting and running a business. The current Edinburgh course also contains this extra weekend. The guest speaker will be **David Balen** and he will be speaking on **Sunday 25th November** from **10am to 5pm** anyone who has already qualified is invited to attend at no charge for the day only £4.00 for teas and coffees. Please let us know if you would like to attend.

EDINBURGH as we have held 3 diploma courses in Edinburgh we had not planned to hold any more there for the foreseeable future. However we have had so many requests for training from all over Scotland that we can no longer ignore them. We held a workshop in

Edinburgh in September and another is planned in Glasgow on the 13th October, with a view to diploma training beginning in Edinburgh and/or Glasgow later in the year.

Now that we have therapists in place to provide therapy for trainees we are making mandatory the requirement that trainees receive at least one session a month from a qualified practitioner. This will provide work for existing therapists and help students with their personal clearing/self development issues.

NEW BONUS SCHEME several therapists have been very pro-active in promoting the Bi-Aura training course and it has been suggested that a financial reward would be appropriate. Being fully aware of the time and effort put in by therapists in promoting the benefits of the course, we thought this was an excellent idea. Consequently we are introducing the following scheme forthwith: A bonus of £5 be paid for each individual a therapist introduces to a workshop and a further £100 if that person goes on to complete the diploma training course.

NEW TRAINERS The demand for training is such that it is no longer possible for Michael to undertake all the training personally. Consequently, the new Scottish course will be facilitated by Lynne Ridley with the able assistance of Helen Geddes, with Michael as overseer. Lynne has assisted training on five courses now and this is an exciting opportunity for her. It is planned that this will be the way of the future with new trainers being brought on through the ranks.

ADVANCED TRAINING the September week end was a great

success. Michael introduced powerful new techniques, approaches and concepts.

Sadly, following a family bereavement, Dr. Atkinson was unable to attend. However the breach was admirably filled at the last moment by **Dr. Robin Gibson**.
